Items that were highlighted at meeting: -Big fundraiser is Hoop-a-Thon- budgeted \$1000 for supplies -Line items in the proposed budget for assemblies, student recognition, student birthdays, Fall Festival, family engagement event in January, field day, garden, school store, student incentive programs and the end of marking periods, supplies/programming for specialists, teacher appreciation, teacher mini-grants to offset cost



		of classroom supplies, volunteer appreciation -\$2500 for field trips- each child is sponsored \$5 for transportation and to offset the cost of trips (485 students x 5) -playground updates- instal new basketball hoop, playground paint, reading and fitness trail- budgeted \$12,500 for playground updates -We have \$6800 in Scholastic dollars. This will be enough funds to cover \$10 per student at the book fair. -Question was posed about where PTA funds come from: Biggest fundraiser around March is the Hoop-a-Thon. Funds are raised through students getting pledge support and themed raffle baskets.
